

He also lectures around the world and provides continuing professional development to healthcare professionals.

Michael has clinical experience working in the National Health Service specialising in lower limb gait rehabilitation post trauma. He has academic experience as a Lecturer in Podiatry (Lower Limb Anatomy and Pathomechanics) and as Head of School at the Birmingham School of Podiatry. Michael's academic interests centre on researching the mechanical behaviour of the heel fibro-fatty padding within gait.
